The Far West Picture

Children and young people

- 22% children live below the poverty line, 861 children.
- 30.4% young people aged 12-17 in the Western NSW and Far West regions are overweight or obese.

Housing and homelessness

• 272 people per 100,000 are homeless.

Aboriginal communities and the justice system

• In 2016-7, 61% of people incarcerated in the Far West were Aboriginal.

Energy and the cost of living

- Across most of regional NSW, average market electricity bills are \$275 higher than those covering Sydney.
- The 2017 Cost of Living Survey showed the average energy bill for people on low incomes in Western NSW was \$2 656, compared to \$1 448 in Metropolitan Sydney.¹

Disability

• The rate of profound or severe disability across the Mid North Coast (6.7.%) is nearly 25% higher than the state average of 4.9%.

¹ These figures were obtained before a 20% increase in retail prices, and are based upon levels of usage that are at or below what is needed to maintain a basic standard of healthy quality of life.
